Santa Barbara has been producing wine commercially since the 70's and increasingly enjoys recognition for world-class wines. Elevation in quality has made possible a Santa Barbara County-only list of sufficient depth & breadth.

Santa Barbara's wine country has several distinct growing areas: Santa Rita Hills on the coast, Santa Ynez Valley and Happy Canyon 30 minutes north of Santa Barbara, Los Alamos and Santa Maria Valleys further north up the coast.

As wine lovers, we appreciate wines from all over the world yet believe there is a lot to be said for a truly regional dining experience. Particularly exciting is the fact that the 'big three' in Santa Barbara— Chardonnay, Pinot Noir & Syrah— are near-universal in their 'food-friendliness' and so feature prominently on our list. We enjoy see guests surprised by the quality and approachability of Viognier, Sauvignon Blanc, and more recently, Cabernet from Happy Canyon in the warmer, inland of Santa Ynez Valley, too.
