Santa Barbara's wine country has several distinct growing areas: Santa Rita Hills on the coast, Santa Ynez Valley and Happy Canyon 30 minutes north of Santa Barbara, Los Alamos and Santa Maria Valleys further north up the coast.

As wine lovers, we enjoy wines from the world over yet believe there is a lot to be said for a regional dining experience.

Particularly exciting are the 'big three' in Santa Barbara— Chardonnay, Pinot Noir & Syrah— and their near-universal their 'food-friendliness' mean they feature prominently on our list. Sauvignon Blanc, and more recently, Cabernet from Happy Canyon in the warmer, Eastern end of Santa Ynez Valley, too.
